Requirements

- ❖ Be a resident of the Sunndi region
- ❖ Be a regular resident of the specific town or county (as described on the Sunndi Resident AR).

Recurring Costs

- ❖ A dedicated Citizen spends at least 2 TU a year in his town of residence.
- ❖ A citizen pays 25 gp worth of taxes each year.

Benefits

- ❖ A respected citizen has a small house in town, which is generally well maintained. As a result, he has free adventurer's upkeep in any scenario set at least partially in his home town. If the citizen already has free adventurer's upkeep from another source, he instead has free rich upkeep.
- ❖ A respected citizen can spend 1000 gp to improve his house and turn it into a small mansion. He now also pays 100 gp a year in taxes. The citizen now has free rich upkeep in any scenario set at least partially in his home town. If the citizen had free adventurer's or better upkeep from another source, he instead has free luxury upkeep.
- ❖ A citizen gets a +2 circumstance bonus on Gather Information checks in the town of residence
- ❖ A citizen gets a +2 circumstance bonus on wither Diplomacy or Intimidate (choose one) checks with citizens of the town of residence, as well as a +2 circumstance bonus on Bluff and Sense Motive when trying to relate or decipher a message to other citizens using innuendo.
- ❖ A +2 circumstance bonus on any Knowledge or Bardic lore check that deals with the town of residence or its inhabitants.
- ❖ A respected citizen can spend 2000 gp to set up a business in town, provided he also has at least 2 ranks in a skill related to that business. A member of the Pitchfield Merchant Guild that starts a business based on a Craft (any) or Profession (any) skill gets sponsored by his guild, and only needs 1000 gp to start a business.
- ❖ A respected citizen who has a business gets a +2 circumstance bonus on the skill with which he set up the business in any scenario that is set partially in his home town, and (if applicable) a +2 circumstance bonus on any Appraise checks if these are related to his business.
